#### 4. RECOMMENDATION TO HUTT CITY AND UPPER HUTT CITY COUNCILS

Proposed Hutt Valley Trade Wastes Bylaw 2016 (16/1043)

The Principal Policy Advisor elaborated on the report.

In response to questions from members, the Manager, Trade Waste advised that the proposed changes to the Trade Waste Bylaw focused on the use of consistent and clear language and creating a more transparent process. He said levels of trade waste had been stable for the last three years.

Members noted that Council officers had discussions with Transpower regarding its submission. Following these discussions, Transpower no longer considered an exclusion specific to substations was necessary to be included in the the proposed Bylaw.

Members thanked the officers for their effort, time and commitment in the consultation and development process of the proposed Hutt Valley Trade Wastes Bylaw.

- (iii) resolves, pursuant to s155 of the Local Government Act 2002, that the proposed Hutt Valley Trade Wastes Bylaw 2016, and associated documents, attached as Appendices 1-3 to the report:
 
  - a) is the most appropriate way of addressing the perceived problem;*
  - b) is the most appropriate form of Bylaw; and*
  - c) does not give rise to any implications under the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990; and**
- (iv) agrees to revoke the existing Hutt Valley Trade Wastes Bylaw 2006 and replace it with the Hutt Valley Trade Wastes Bylaw 2016, attached as Appendix 3 to the report, effective 1 November 2016."*
